ORGANIZATIONAL HISTORY

The Southbury League of Women Voters was a local league that fell under the larger League of Women Voters of Connecticut. The League is a nonpartisan organization consisting of local men and women who volunteer their time to educate the community on public policy, the voting process and elections, and political candidates. The Southbury League held many meet the candidate events, as well as candidate's debates and policy discussion forums.

SCOPE & CONTENT NOTE

The collection consists of personal records of the donor pertaining to her membership with the organization, as well as papers and documents given to her over time by fellow organizational members. Newspaper articles, event flyers, and press releases make up the bulk of the collection.

SYSTEM OF ARRANGEMENT
